



THANK YOU for the large number of positive comments that we have received regarding the **garden screens** and the **slate plaques** that adorn

the Church car park walls! The floral slate plaques, each donated by parishioners, carry some of the historic titles for Our Lady from across the UK.

Further **slate plaques** carry the names of St Joseph, St Gregory the Great and the names of our national patrons, e.g., see above. The screens are **numbered with plaques** bearing an image of the Westminster Cathedral Cross (see below); these can now be used to pray the Stations of the Cross; the 'Notre Dame School Cross' is the XV Station (The Resurrection).

There are also large **slate plaques** that feature the names of saints connected with Pope St Gregory the Great and other slate plaques with the names of saints associated with great moments in the history of the Church in this country, e.g. St Carlo Acutis.
