Sacred Scripture Resource 1: An online gathering on Wednesday, 21st January from 7:30pm to 9pm to introduce the purpose and theme of "The Sunday of the Word of God". Email Deacon Peter to register: deaconpeter.collins@northamptondiocese.org

Sacred Scripture Resource 2: Next Sunday, 25th January is the "Sunday of the Word of God" (which was instituted by Pope Francis); this is when we consciously remind ourselves to more attentively engage with the Sacred Scriptures proclaimed at Mass; for truly Jesus Christ "is made present" as He speaks to us both individually and as a community.

Sacred Scripture Resource 3: Next Sunday, 25th January there is a special Liturgy of the Word with reflections by Fr Jerome Ituah in our Cathedral at 3:00pm to celebrate the "Sunday of the Word of God". The liturgy will include the commissioning of Lectors/Readers to proclaim the Holy Scriptures.

Sacred Scripture Resource 4: Join a very special gathering on Saturday, 31st January from 11am to 3pm for Lectors/Readers of the Holy Scriptures at Mass to reflect on their important liturgical role. Holy Ghost Centre, Luton. Refreshments available.

Sacred Scripture Resource 5: A series of online sessions exploring the Holy Scripture readings and the seasons of the liturgical year. The next session is on Wednesday, 11th February (exploring Lent and

Holy Week). Each online session is from 7:30pm to 8:30pm and includes prayer, input and the chance to comment and ask questions. This is offered by the diocesan Liturgical Formation Team with many different presenters, including Fr Andrew Behrens.

Sacred Scripture Resource 6: "Journey with Jesus through Lent" by participating in an online group session once a week for six weeks beginning on 16th February. Facilitators will be using the St Beuno's Outreach Prego resource to pray and reflect on the Sunday Scripture Readings. Sessions will be on various days and times. 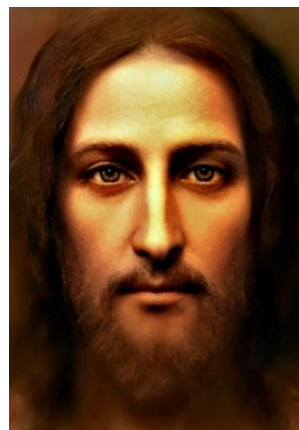

The Holy Face of Jesus Novena

This Novena begins on Monday, 9th February and concludes on Tuesday, 17th February (which is Shrove Tuesday). This devotion focuses on the Holy Face of Jesus unveiled on the Holy Cross, making this a wonderful way to prepare

for Lent. This is being offered for all the Deacons, Priests and Religious of our Diocese and/or for a specific Deacon, Priest or Religious known to you, that he/she/they will reveal the Holy Face of Jesus Christ to all to whom they minister.
