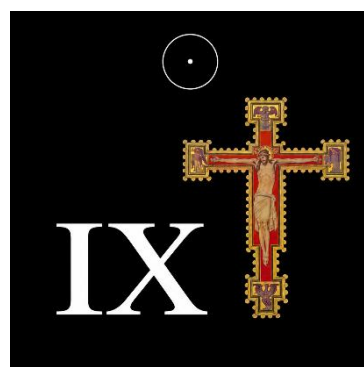
## Yes, we return to St Gregory's Church
