
### Come and See - Discernment Day for Men:

We extend our very sincere appreciation to those parishioners who have recently

purchased (and then paid for the installation of) decorative screens for the long wall and hall wall of the Church car park. These are very striking and will soon be joined by floral slate plaques with some of the historic titles for Our Lady from across the UK. Further screens have now been affixed to the aforementioned walls and soon slate plaques will be added featuring the names of St Joseph, St Gregory the Great (like that above) and the Patron Saints of England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, as well the flowers that are closely associated with each saint and/or nation.



### • St John Henry Newman: Pray for us!

The (optional) Memorial of **St John Henry Newman**, a Doctor of the Church, has been added to the liturgical calendar (9<sup>th</sup> October) for the whole Church by Pope Leo. Led by the “kindly light” of God’s grace, his journey from Protestantism to the safe harbours of the Catholic Church speaks to each of us: that we be lead “out of shadows and images into the fullness of truth” that is Jesus Christ. → → → Copies of the above image are available for free at the entrance/exit of the hall.

**Pope Leo, Lent 2026:** “Dear brothers and sisters, Lent is a time in which the Church, guided by a sense of maternal care, invites us to place the mystery of God back in the centre of our lives, in order to find renewal in our faith and keep our hearts from being consumed by the anxieties and distractions of daily life. Every path towards conversion begins by allowing the word of God to touch our hearts and welcoming it with a docile spirit. There is a relationship between the word, our acceptance of it and the conversion it brings about. For this reason, the Lenten journey is a welcome opportunity to heed the voice of the Lord and renew our commitment to following Christ, accompanying him on the road to Jerusalem, where the mystery of his passion, death and resurrection will be fulfilled.”

**A young man from Manchester** who “committed himself totally to God” could one day be included among the rank of saints as requests are made for him to be canonised. Pedro Ballester died in 2018, aged just 21, of bone cancer after a life of heroic prayer, sacrifice and virtue. Vatican officials are now in the process of gauging whether a ‘cause’ for his canonisation should be formally opened.



**March** is dedicated to St Joseph and to honour this tradition, and to participate in Missio’s great novena of prayer, **specially made chaplets** will be available to buy on **Sun., 1<sup>st</sup>** (when they will be blessed) and **Sunday, 8<sup>th</sup> March** at the

**price of £3.** £1 from the sale of each Chaplet will be given to the children’s branch of Missio and will be available in a limited number. This novena will be offered for our intentions, the Pontifical Mission Societies (Missio) and the Saint Joseph Missionary Society of Mill Hill, which was founded in 1866.
