



Opening prayer (together):

Blessed Cyprian Tansi, during your life on earth you showed your great faith and love in giving yourself to your people; by the hidden life of prayer and contemplation. Look upon us now in our needs, and intercede for us with the lord. May He grant us the favours we ask through your prayers. Amen.

(In two minutes silence, recall in your hearts your intentions for the prayer meeting).

The five decades of the Joyful Mystery of the Rosary is said:

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the heart of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

L: Send forth your spirit and they shall be created,

R: And you shall renew the face of the earth.

Let us pray (together):

O God, who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit; grant that, by the same Holy Spirit, we may always be truly wise, and ever rejoice in his consolation through Christ our Lord. Amen.

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth. And in Jesus Christ, His only Son our Lord; who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary; suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit; the Holy Catholic Church; the Communion of Saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

One Our Father & three Hail Marys are said for intention of the Pope.

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name.

Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee: Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, mother of God, pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour of our death. Amen (3 times).

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fire of hell, lead all souls to heaven especially those who are in most need of your mercy.

At the end of the Holy Rosary:

Bidding prayers

Leader: With all our hearts and minds, let us lay our requests before the Lord:

- a) Inspire all those who lead and serve in the Catholic Church to follow your guidance and direction; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- b) Show us how to serve You in one another, to offer love, care and support; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- c) Protect all those who carry peace to other nations, bless the food, the care and shelter they provide for those in need; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- d) Comfort those who live with loneliness, and heal those sick in body, mind, soul and spirit; may they feel You close to them; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- e) Please Lord, comfort those who have lost loved ones recently, heal their broken hearts; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- f) Receive the supplication of all the Blessed Tansi prayer groups, may they receive your care, love and support through your servant Blessed Cyprian; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**
- g) Bless our intentions in this prayer meeting and may they come to pass according to your Holy will, which is love and mercy; **Lord in Your Mercy; Hear our prayer**

In silence let us add our own personal intentions.

Let us pray together:

Heavenly Father, Your son Jesus Christ calls all those who are burdened to come to him, to find rest , we ask You to hear the prayers we have offered by the power of the Holy Spirit and intercession of your servant, Blessed Cyprian Tansi. Amen.

Reading from the writings of Blessed Tansi:

“Let us remember in our daily joys and daily sorrows the God of the tabernacle, who delights to remain with the children of men”

“Let Christian Charity be our norm of relationship with everybody irrespective of colour and nationality, and we shall be fulfilling the law of Christ”

“While we have time, let us lay up treasures in heaven so that on the day of reckoning our reward may be great indeed”

“Let us show ourselves true children of God, whose sun shines on the just and on the unjust. Let us prove ourselves docile disciples of Christ our Lord, whose compassion for men knows no bounds”

Novena for the Canonisation of Blessed Tansi (together):

O God, who granted many graces to your Blessed Servant priest and monk, Cyprian Michael Iwene Tansi, choosing him as your faithful instrument for evangelisation and sanctification of your people, grant also that I may spend my life, loving you and my neighbour and serving the Church. Deign to glorify your servant Cyprian Michael and through his intercession grant us the favours we ask of You; **(pause for silent petition)**, we ask this through Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

Act of Consecration of the Family to the Divine Mercy

O Jesus, You showed us Your infinite compassionate love by exhausting the very last drop of blood and water from Your body. From this day forward, with full confidence, we entrust our families to Your Divine mercy. We abandon our past, our present and our future. We place into Your wounds all of our wounds which are caused by lack of love, understanding and trust. Jesus, expel Satan and all evil from our families, free us from the consequence of sin and protect us from further harm. Heal our wounds. May our families learn to venerate your Divine Image that they will never perish but experience Your loving mercy. **Amen.**

Concluding Prayer:

Heavenly Father, as we come to the end of our time together, we thank You for our session today. We have presented our cares and concerns of life and trust that You will meet us with grace and goodness. Give us the strength, the wisdom and the courage to follow Your will and Your way so that we will always hope the best that Your son our Lord Jesus Christ has to offer. We make our prayer through our Lord Jesus Christ, Your son and through the intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary and Blessed Cyprian Michael Iwene Tansi forever and ever. **Amen.**
